TI Rules are very simple. Please make this a positive experience for everyone by following them.

1. DO abstain from the use of tobacco, vape, alcohol & other drugs.
2. DO arrive at camp on time and stay the entire weekend.
3. DO wear YOUR name tag at all times.
4. DO behave in a responsible manner and respect the rights and property of others. Please be respectful of the members of the staff & the facility.
5. DO maintain the grounds and facilities of your host (clean up after yourself!)
6. DO be on time and actively participate in all scheduled activities.
7. DO NOT engage in physical contact or activity connoting sexual intimacy with other participants or staff.
8. DO stay in the camp during the entire event.
9. DO follow all Cabin Rules including:
 - a. Maintain quiet hours in the cabins after head count.
 - b. Stay in cabins after head count and until 7 am
 - c. DO NOT enter cabins occupied by members of the opposite sex except for schedule groups or workshops.
10. Do take a risk, try something new, experience the different opportunities.

Do comply with any and all other rules determined as necessary for the success of the program. Compliance with these rules is expected of all Participants and Staff. Infractions will result in possible dismissal from the program!

WHAT TO BRING

Bedding & Towels – sleeping bag, sheets, blankets, pillow, towels, **bedding is NOT provided!!

All program activities at Recreation Unlimited are activities by choice. It is the responsibility of the participant or Lease Group representative for the participant to choose not to participate in an activity that may adversely affect physical or mental health.
